Article publishing will depend on the correctness of the document following the editorial rules and the "ad hoc" Reviewers' report. All reviews will be taken confidentially and impartially. Editorial orientations

Full articles - The manuscript may be written in Portuguese or English - please have a fully revised grammar version before submission. All scientific articles must have: title, abstract, keywords, introduction, material and methods, results, discussion, conclusion, Acknowledgements (optional), and references. The results and discussion may be written in one part.

Review articles – Review articles must follow the same scientific rigorousness of the full articles, with a specific format (title, abstract, keywords, introduction, development in subtitles/items, future perspectives, conclusion, acknowledgements (optional), references). The publication of review articles will depend of the relevance and relevance of the topic, scientific merit, and the authors' knowledge.
